Key California Manufacturing Bills

AB 197 (E. Garcia) Post-2020 Climate Change Policy – OPPOSE

Increases the cost of compliance by directing CARB to use command-and-control regulations targeting industrial and transportation sectors and undermines cost-effectiveness requirements by including the "social cost of carbon". Adds limited legislative oversight with nonvoting legislative appointments to ARB and a joint review committee.

Vote Record: Assembly & Senate

Status Signed by the Governor (Chapter 250)

AB 1066 (Gonzalez) Agricultural Overtime Exception – OPPOSE

Repeals the longstanding 10-hour daily overtime exception for agricultural workers over the course of four years, with smaller employers having an additional three years to comply. The bill also authorizes the Governor to delay the implementation of these overtime pay provisions if he also suspends the implementation of the scheduled state minimum wage increase. This change could result in cost reduction strategies that negatively impact manufacturers who provide the goods and services that support the agricultural industry.

Vote Record: Assembly & Senate

Status: Signed by the Governor (Chapter 313)

AB 1520 (Asm Judiciary Cmte) Public Records – OPPOSE

Makes utility user data for commercial, industrial and institutional customers open and available to the public under the California Public Records Act (CPRA) by eliminating an existing exemption to the disclosure under the Act.

Vote Record: Senate

Status: Failed Deadline, Senate Floor

AB 1643 (Gonzalez) Permanent Disability Apportionment – OPPOSE

Prohibits apportionment in workers' compensation cases of physical injury based on pregnancy, menopause, osteoporosis, and carpal tunnel syndrome and requires that breast cancer not be less than the comparable impairment rating for prostate cancer.

Vote Record: Assembly & Senate

Status: Vetoed by the Governor

AB 2895 (R. Hernandez) Injury Prevention Programs – OPPOSE

Requires employers to keep a complete written copy of their injury and illness prevention plans at any worksite with three or more employees and make it available to new, existing employees, their representative and Cal/OSHA.

Vote Record: Assembly

Status: Failed Deadline, Senate Floor

SB 32 (Pavley) 2030 Climate Change Goal – OPPOSE

Requires ARB to establish a GHG emission limit of at least 40 percent below 1990 levels by 2030.

Vote Record: Assembly & Senate

Status: Signed by the Governor (Chapter 249)

SB 654 (Jackson) Parental Leave – OPPOSE

Mandates small employers (20 employees within 75 miles of the worksite) to grant employees six weeks of protected parental leave to bond with a new child within one year of the child's birth, adoption or foster care placement. Also prohibits an employer from refusing to maintain and pay for employees' continued group health coverage during the duration of the leave.

Vote Record: Assembly & Senate

Status: Vetoed by the Governor

SB 1167 (Mendoza) Indoor Heat Regulations – OPPOSE

Requires Cal/OSHA to create a heat illness standard for indoor workers by July 1, 2019. The standard must be based on environmental temperatures, work activity levels, and other factors and Cal/OSHA must take into consideration heat stress and heat strain guidelines developed by the American Conference of Governmental Industrial Hygienists.

Vote Record: Assembly & Senate

Status: Signed by the Governor (Chapter 839)

SB 1383 (Lara) Short-lived Climate Pollutants – OPPOSE

Requires CARB to approve and implement a strategy to reduce short-lived climate pollutants, including methane, hydrofluorocarbon gases, and black carbon, by specified percentages by 2030 based on 2013 levels. Limits for solid waste and dairy sectors delayed several years.

Vote Record: Assembly & Senate

Status: Signed by the Governor (Chapter 395)

SB 1387 (De León) South Coast Air Quality District Oversight – OPPOSE

Increases Sacramento control of the South Coast Air Quality Management District Board by doubling state-level appointments to this local air board. This shift away from local control results in more than one-third of the board seats being held by Sacramento appointees.

Vote Record: Assembly & Senate

Status: Failed Passage, Assembly Floor
